Joe Rogan has been trying to escape consequences for irresponsibly broadcasting ignorant nonsense by using a dodge that weak-minded media hacks have employed for decades.

He claims that he's just trying to have "interesting conversations" on air with controversial people because he wants to hear their thoughts. ### Bellingcat: Russia's FSB Officer Played Crucial Role in MH17 Downing

A general with Russia's intelligence service could be the highest-ranking official identified as having been involved in the downing of Malaysian Airlines Flight MH17 in 2014 that killed 298 people, the investigative outlet Bellingcat revealed in its latest investigation published on Tuesday in cooperation with Russia's The Insider.

Colonel General Andrey Ivanovich Burlaka of the Russian Federal Security Service (FSB), according to the report, could have been the one who supervised the movement of weapons from Russia to Ukraine, including the Buk missile launcher that shot the plane after crossing the border from Russia.

Bellingcat and The Insider found that Burlaka could be the person behind the name "Vladimir Ivanovich," whose phone conversations with Ukrainian separatist commanders were intercepted and are part of the investigation into the plane's downing.

All 283 passengers and 15 crew members were killed when Malaysia Airlines Flight 17 - MH17, heading from Amsterdam to Kuala Lumpur, was shot down while flying over eastern Ukraine on July 17, 2014.

"In November 2019, the Dutch-led Joint Investigation Team (JIT) announced the broadening of its criminal investigation into the shoot-down of MH17 to encompass the role of individuals within Russia's military and administrative hierarchy who enabled the tragedy," the Bellingcat report said.





- In a previous series of investigations, Bellingcat uncovered evidence that Russia's military intelligence agency the GRU was responsible for both the <u>Novichok poisoning of Sergey and Yulia Skripal</u> in the U.K. (an assassination attempt that led to the death of one British citizen) and the <u>poisoning of Emilian Gebrev</u> in Bulgaria. We also <u>determined that</u> Russia's principal security agency the FSB was behind the assassination of a Georgian asylum seeker on German soil.
- In a further joint investigation, Bellingcat uncovered evidence that Russia has not terminated its chemical weapons program, but has instead disguised its development capability behind a network of state-run institutes. Following the official closure of Russia's military-run chemical weapons program in 2010, its core scientists were rehired by institutes which engage in ostensibly civilian research. In reality, these scientists continued to provide chemical weapons development and manufacturing support to Russia's security services.
- We identified two institutes which since 2010 appear to have taken the lead role in the continued R&D of Soviet-era nerve-agent programs, including those of the Novichok type. These institutes - the St Petersburg-based <u>GNII VM</u> and the







# Musk weighs in on Ukrainian counteroffensive

The Tesla and Twitter owner appeared to agree with an article alleging that Kiev's attempts to reclaim lost territory are failing

Tesla and Twitter CEO Elon Musk has endorsed an article by investor and entrepreneur David Sacks arguing that Ukraine's military push against Russia is faltering.

On Tuesday, Sacks posted an article on Twitter, claiming "it's becoming clear that the Ukrainian counteroffensive is failing to achieve any of its originally stated objectives. Washington's bet that Kiev would be able to "roll back Russian territorial gains, cut the land bridge to Crimea" and make it engage in negotiations had not paid off, he added.

"On the contrary, a stalemate is more likely, or even that Russia will take more territory and win the war," the investor stated.

He went on to compare the situation in Ukraine with the US military campaign in Afghanistan, which ended with a chaotic withdrawal of US troops in 2020. "It's worth recalling that the American public was assured for two decades that we were winning in Afghanistan," Sacks wrote, adding that any belief that the local military was "standing up" to the Taliban crumbled

"Unfortunately, it looks like we're headed for a similar kind of outcome in Ukraine. The only question is when, and how long Biden will be able to perpetuate a proxy war of choice that could have easily been avoided," he

Musk appeared to agree with Sacks' take on Ukraine, writing on Twitter: "Well

Meanwhile, Sacks pointed to new evidence showing that Moscow and Kiev could have come to an agreement at the very start of the conflict last year, referring to a draft treaty on neutrality and security guarantees for Ukraine shown by Russian President Vladimir Putin earlier this week.

However, the negotiations on the matter broke down in the spring 2022 after Ukraine accused Russia of committing war crimes, a claim Moscow has vehemently denied. The alleged atrocities were discovered after Russian troops withdrew from areas around Kiev in a "goodwill gesture," according to Moscow.

Kiev's troops launched their long-anticipated offensive in early June, but their attacks have failed to gain any ground, according to the Russian Defense Ministry, which last week estimated Ukrainian frontline losses since the start of the push at 7,500. Meanwhile, Putin has claimed that Ukraine has lost up to 30% of its Western-supplied military equipment.

# Elon Musk dubs 2014 Ukraine regime change a 'coup'

The billionaire described Viktor Yanukovich's election as 'dodgy' but said the coup was beyond question

Twitter CEO Elon Musk polarized his followers with a tweet declaring there was "no question" that the 2014 change of government in Ukraine was a "coup." On Saturday, the billionaire tweeted that while "the electrion" – presumably referring to the 2010 vote that elected Viktor Yanukovich president – was "arguably dodgy," what followed "was indeed a coup."

The tweet was a response to a post from user @KanekoaTheGreat that featured the front page of an article by University of Chicago Professor John Mearsheimer titled "Why the Ukraine Crisis is The West's Fault." Dating from 2014, the piece – subtled "The Liberal Delusions That Provoked Putin" – argues that "NATO enlargement" and Western meddling in Ukrainian politics, and not "Russian"

aggression," are to blame for Crimea's accession to Russia.

Mearsheimer states that "for Putin, the illegal overthrow of Ukraine's democratically-elected and pro-Russian president – which he rightly labeled a 'coup' – was the final straw," an explanation Musk appeared to agree with, at least in part.



While the 2010 election that installed Yanukovich as president was deemed an "impressive display" of democracy by the Organization for Security and Cooperation in Europe, the West sourced on the Party of Regions politician when he abandoned a 2013 economic cooperation agreement with


Massive violent protests followed, forcing Yanukovich to flee. The US' hand in the unrest was confirmed in a leaked phone call between then-assistant US Secretary of State Victoria Nuland and US ambassador to Ukraine Geoffrey Pyatt in which they appeared to be plotting to overthrow Yanukovich and install Arseniy Yatseniuk – who indeed briefly became Prime Minister following Yanukovich's ouster.

Musk also replied approvingly to a previous post by Kanekoa that featured a video clip of All In podcast host David Sacks claiming that the US "courted" the Ukraine conflict. The video likened Nuland to former Biden administration medical adviser Anthory Fauo, a frequent target of Musk's ire.





In a bitter £650million legal battle at the High Court, aluminium tycoon Oleg Deripaska was alleged to have ties to brutal organised crime gangs which emerged after the collapse of Communism in the former Soviet Union.

He vehemently denies the allegations – revealed in legal papers filed as part of the case – and counter-claimed that he was the victim of an 'old-fashioned protection racket' run by the Mafia-style gangs.


