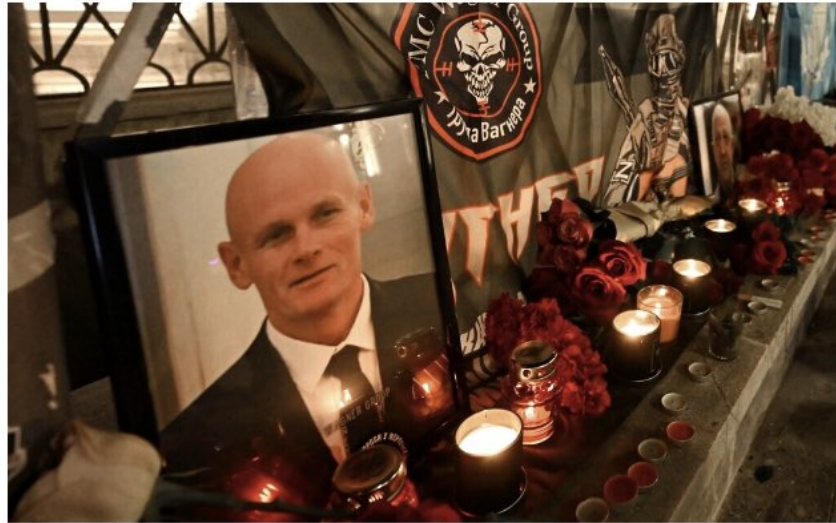

EBAM, Cameroon—It was the “most barbaric” act of violence Nas Ali said he has witnessed since the [Central African Republic \(CAR\)](#) welcomed Russian mercenaries from the [infamous Wagner Group](#), which some have called [Vladimir Putin's “private army,”](#) about four years ago.

Like most refugees, Alabdullah has a traumatic story to tell. Only his is not his own but that of his much younger cousin, Muhammad Taha Ismail Alabdullah, more commonly known as Hamadi Bouta.

In 2017, Bouta, a Syrian army deserter, was kidnapped and tortured on camera by a handful of mercenaries affiliated with the Wagner Group, a notorious paramilitary organization financed by the Western-sanctioned Russian oligarch and catering magnate Yevgeny Prigozhin. The U.S. has labeled Wagner a "proxy force" of the Russian Ministry of Defense, and its ties to the GRU, Russia's military intelligence service, are well established.

The murder movie shot by Wagner is stomach-turning. A carousel of four Russian-speaking men took turns beating Bouta with a sledgehammer. Then they cut off his hands and head with a shovel before stringing up his corpse by the feet and setting it alight. "Of course I couldn't finish the video," Alabdullah says, adding that there's a longer version of it his relatives have seen. "They told me about the rest: that his head was cut off and they played soccer with it, kicking it at the wall with their feet."

Russia's Wagner Group Says Sending Blood-Stained Sledgehammer to EU Parliament

The Kremlin-linked leader of the notorious Wagner mercenary group [said](#) Wednesday that he sent a sledgehammer to be delivered to the European Parliament in a dark reminder of one fighter's gruesome killing.

Yevgeny Prigozhin's threatening gesture came as the EU Parliament prepared to condemn Wagner in a non-binding resolution after branding Russia a "[state sponsor of terrorism](#)."

Prigozhin's Concord firm [said](#) he had discussed the anticipated EU Parliament vote with Wagner commanders and decided to respond with what he described as a "case of information."

Video [emerged](#) later Wednesday showing a Prigozhin associate brandishing a violin case containing a sledgehammer with the inscription "PMC Wagner" on its head and artificial blood stains on its handle.

It remains unclear if he can return to Russia, but he has capitalized on his feud with the generals to fashion himself as a populist political figure, fighting for humble servicemen and others suffering at the hands of “unqualified scoundrels and intriguants.”

He has contrasted that with what he sees as the decadence of Russian elites and the injustice in society.

“The children of the elite smear themselves with creams, showing it on the internet; ordinary people’s children come in zinc, torn to pieces,” he said, referring to the coffins of dead soldiers, and adding that those killed in action had “tens of thousands” of relatives.

“Society always demands justice,” he said, “and if there is no justice, then revolutionary sentiments arise.”

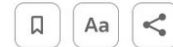

Mercenary Prigozhin warns Russia could face revolution unless elite gets serious about war

Prigozhin has also waged a relentless defamation campaign against the Russian MoD and the military command since May 2022 – first covertly via Wagner-affiliated ultranationalist social media platforms. Wagner-affiliated milbloggers began to boast about Wagner’s successes in assault operations and even spread the idea that Prigozhin could replace Shoigu as defense minister in September 2022. [14] These milbloggers capitalized on the increasing criticism among the Russian ultranationalist communities aimed at the Russian conventional military command that failed to maintain the initiative following the exhausting capture of Lysychansk and Severodonetsk. Wagner was able to exploit the greater ultranationalist community because the ultranationalists shared the objective of improving the war effort and saw a common enemy in the Russian MoD and its bureaucracy. The ultranationalist community had also been extremely interconnected over the years prior to the full-scale Russian invasion of Ukraine and drew on the same recruitment pools.
