Rublyovsky Highway

At the end of that year, on November 14th, 2010, Jorrit Faassen is driving his BMW down the Rublyovsky Highway, a wide six-lane road on the west side of Moscow. Suddenly, he is cut off by a Mercedes and a Volkswagen. He is forced to stop. 'Several men jumped from the cars and attacked me with clubs,' Faassen will later tell the police ☺. 'They smashed the side windows of my car and beat me up. Then, they jumped back into their cars and fled towards the center of Moscow.'

Faassen, who sustains minor injuries, manages to memorize the cars' plates. Later that day, the perpetrators are arrested: powerful banker Matvey Urin and his bodyguards. In addition, the licenses of Urin's banks are revoked. In Russia, the reaction is one of surprise: how can one young, unknown foreigner pressing charges bring down such a powerful banker?

The story is quickly picked up by, among others, Dutch media entrepreneur Derk Sauer's *The Moscow Times*, and *Business Insider*. *Radio Netherlands Worldwide* reports that Faassen is 'not known in Dutch business circles in Moscow'.

In 2011, Faassen was beaten up in Moscow by the security guards of a banker named Matvey Urin because Faassen's car had not allowed Urin's motorcade to pass. This ended up being a costly affair for Urin. Almost immediately, his motorcade was **personally stopped** by the head of the Moscow police department, Vladimir Kolokoltsev, not far from the Kremlin. Urin and his guards were first sentenced to 3 years in prison for hooliganism, then Urin got another 7.5 years for fraud. Kolokoltsev, on the other hand, was given the position of Minister of Internal Affairs.

Convicted Russian banker Matvei Urin charged in another fraud case - report

MOSCOW, May 28 (RAPS) – Another case has been opened against Russian banker and convicted fraudster Matvei Urin. He is suspected of having embezzled \$2.7 million from Slavyansky Bank, Kommersant newspaper writes on Wednesday.

According to the newspaper, Urin, who was sentenced to 7.5 years in prison for embezzling 16 billion rubles (over \$460 million), is the only suspect in yet another fraud case. The investigators presume that in July 2010 he illegally withdrew 94 million rubles (\$2.7 million) from Slavyansky Bank client deposits.

A source told Kommersant the case against Urin was opened under the articles on money laundering. The source said that charges would be brought against Urin within the next few days, because “the investigators have collected sufficient evidence of his involvement in organizing the criminal scheme.”



Maria is a PhD candidate at the Endocrinology Research Centre in Moscow, which runs a charity project, Alfa-Endo, that helps children affected by endocrine ailments. The project’s website includes a presentation by Maria.
