In 2014, Vivek established Roivant Sciences, based in Bermuda, with nearly \$100 million in funding from various investors, including his former employer, the hedge fund QVT. To legitimize his venture, he assembled an impressive advisory board, comprising both Democrats and Republicans, all convinced that they were part of an **endeavor to bring critical drugs to the market** affordably.

However, behind the scenes, Vivek was manipulating the system. Despite his efforts to present RVT-101 as a game-changer, the drug continued to fail, and Vivek's elaborate **scheme began to crumble**. Investors who had placed their faith and money into the venture lost billions as the stock price crashed by over 99%.

Anyone can make changes to Wikipedia articles, but it's against the rules for anyone to edit an article about themselves. It's within the rules to pay someone else to make changes on Wikipedia articles as long as those payments are disclosed.

GOP candidates during the first Republican debate argued over climate change, with Vivek Ramaswamy calling the agenda over the issue a hoax.

“I’m the only candidate on stage who isn’t bought and paid for, so I can say this — the climate change agenda is a hoax,” he said.

“And so the reality is more people are dying of bad climate change policies than they are of actual climate change,” he added.

Vivek Ramaswamy: “The reality is the anti-carbon agenda is the wet blanket on our economy. And so the reality is more people are dying of bad climate change policies than they are of actual climate change.”





Ramaswamy didn't explain his evidence, and it was unclear what he was referencing — his campaign didn't immediately respond to us. But data from a number of credible sources shows the human toll from climate change is significant.

Worldwide, extreme weather disasters made worse by climate change caused more than 2 million deaths between 1970 and 2021, the World Meteorological Organization said in a [May 2023 report](#). The [World Health Organization](#) reported in November that at least 15,000 people died due to the heat in 2022. And the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention says that [600 people a year die](#) from heat-related illnesses, although [experts told PolitiFact](#) that number is likely an undercount.

Summer 2023 has set [record temperatures](#) in the U.S. and across the globe, with July the hottest month on record. Extreme temperatures that month were made at least three times likelier [because of human-caused climate change](#), one research group found.

His views on climate change reflect how he straddles the line between sounding thoughtful and outlandish.

In an interview, Ramaswamy said he's “not a climate denier,” but sees the world's warming as “not entirely bad.” He says the goal of limiting carbon emissions is “flawed” and that “people should be proud to live a high-carbon lifestyle.” He said “we have a far better chance” of growing out of the problem “than trying to engineer the climate itself.”
