Dima was previously stationed in Warsaw, from where he then moved on to work in New York to work under Vasily Nebenzya, the current Permanent Representative of Russia to the United Nations, and the man who had to announce the infamous "Ukrainian combat mosquitos".

We couldn't reach out to Dmitry's wife, Maria, for a comment on the matter.






Blair Says Iragis Could Launch Chemical Warheads in Minutes

Sees Nuclear Weapon Capability in 1 to 5 Years

serted today that the Iraqi government of President Saddam Hussein could launch chemical or biological warheads within 45 minutes of an order to use them and acquire a nuclear weapon in one to five years.

The claims were made in a 50-page report intended to bolster the Bush administration's case against the Iraqi leader and released today a few hours before Prime Minister Tony Blair outlined to British lawmakers his case for war if necessary to make Iraq disarm.

Addressing an emergency session of Parliament, Mr. Blair said: "Our case is simply this. Not that we take

LONDON, Sept. 24 - Britain as- Iraq responded with contempt, calling the report a collection of "exag-geration and lies" and saying United Nations weapons inspectors would be granted "unfettered access" to go wherever they wanted upon their expected return to Iraq in the next several weeks.

During a heated, 11-hour debate in Parliament after Mr. Blair's statement, several lawmakers from the prime minister's Labor Party criticized him sharply. But there was also vigorous and widespread praise for his stand. In general, opposition to the Bush administration's war plans is less strong in Britain than elsewhere in Europe, where it is often virulent.






Azov commanders who returned to Ukraine after prisoner swap say they plan to continue fighting

Denys Prokopenko, a commander of the Azov Regiment who returned to Ukraine, <u>told</u> journalists in Lviv the commanders plan to continue fighting. He was one of five Azov commanders who <u>flew back</u> to Ukraine from Turkey on July 8, accompanied by Ukrainian president Volodymyr Zelensky. They were released from Russian captivity in a prisoner swap.

In response to a question about whether the Azov commanders would return to the front, Prokopenko said, "Of course. That's why we returned. That's our main goal."

Earlier, Kremlin spokesman Dmitry Peskov <u>accused</u> Turkey and Ukraine of breaking the terms of the agreement that freed the commanders from Russian captivity. According to Peskov, the deal required the five commanders to remain in Turkey "until the end of the conflict."



On 14 Jul 2023, Dima appeared on "Maverick News" together with elite war analyst and convicted sex criminal, Scott Ritter. The discussion revolved around "NATO expansion", "money laundering" in Ukraine, evil "Ukrainian Nazis" and how Zelensky "let down the Ukrainians".



To conclude: Polyanskiy is an SVR officer who keeps close contact with many of the Western vatniks, probably even collaborating and coordinating together with them.


