G's online activities attracted criticism from the Russian authorities, and drew attention from a local news site in Omsk. He was described as a traitor, & in defending himself he somewhat ironically described the "Russian" mindset that he himself would later fall into.

An Internet project called “[Rashka Vatnik](#)” specializes in publishing satirical comics on social networks, the main theme of which is grotesquery on the theme of Russian patriotism. The hero of the humorous stories “Rashka Vatnik” is a caricature character of the same name, endowed, according to the authors, with the characteristic attributes of an ardent patriot. He wears a winter padded jacket, constantly drinks alcohol, carries the national flag, plays the balalaika, shouts slogans, and under his eye he always has a blue black eye.



The resource administrator, a native of [REDACTED] who took the surname of his American wife and has been living in Mexico for more than a year, admits that he is not welcomed in his hometown.

“Rashka Vatnik” was also subjected to violent criticism from former fellow countrymen of [REDACTED] Omsk politicians.

“This is nothing more than primitive humor performed by narrow-minded people, not worthy of public attention. Such people do not have any moral principles. Naturally, I, as a citizen, am offended to see this when the country is mixed with crap, trying to gain popularity among the liberal community,” Alexey Baykov, leader of the Omsk youth wing of the Communist Party of the Russian Federation, told SuperOmsk.

The Omsk branch of the Rodina party calls [REDACTED] nothing less than a traitor.

“We have a democratic country in which everyone can have their own point of view. However, what this creature writes cannot be called anything other than betrayal. Such people need to be tried, and publicly, for their complicity with the United States and the Ukrainian junta. And it doesn’t matter where they are now. We believe that Roskomnadzor should block this account, protecting it from society,” says Valery Stolbunov, chairman of the regional branch of the Rodina party.

[REDACTED] himself does not see anything prejudiced in Vatnik’s adventures.

“Sharp social satire, in this case it is Rashka Kvadratny Vatnik, is the very counterbalance to official Kremlin propaganda. We make fun of the capricious patriotism, the Soviet mentality of people who prefer to live in the past. The cartoons that we publish very accurately reflect the life, interests and way of thinking of the average Russian who watches Russian television and blindly believes everything they say. The problem with the Russian mentality is that these people have never seen or known freedom. We are for freedom, for the right to express ourselves and for the right to ridicule the “vatness” of Russian society in any way!” [REDACTED] told SuperOmsk.

A far cry from his current views, G once believed that Russia was an imperialist power that was illegally occupying its neighbors, & that Russia should be broken into 14 parts. These views brought him to the attention of nationalists & attracted the attention of the FSB.

Since that time, since 2007 [REDACTED] and his supporters have been promoting the idea of dividing the Russian Federation into 14 independent states. The term "vatnik" was coined by his friend and partner [REDACTED] in 2012 before the events in Ukraine: at first, "vatnik" ridiculed the Russian "cattle" - jingoistic patriots who care for the power of Russia. Before the war in the south-east of Ukraine, only citizens of the Russian Federation were members of the "Rashka square quilted jacket" group. Now 43% of subscribers to their public are Ukrainians. The 2000s generation grew up on the articles of the groups founded by [REDACTED] and illustrated by [REDACTED] when they appeared online, subscribers were 12-15 years old; now they are adults, financially independent people. At the beginning of the emergence of groups calling for the return of the Kuril Islands to Japan, Kaliningrad to Germany and the lease of part of the Far East to China, there were about 700 people, now their total reach is more than 2 million. The most famous groups: "Ukrainian offensive-21" - 512 participants, "ATO/Cyborg" (450,046), "Rashka square quilted jacket" (66,110) [REDACTED] is the administrator of some of them.

After the FSB issued a notice for his arrest, he fled to Mexico, where despite claims to be in Siberia, he resides today. According to Russian news articles at the time, G supposedly adopted surname from his American wife, as opposed to his original, Russian one.

[REDACTED] met in Almaty with [REDACTED] who is on the list of people denigrating Russia.

His page on the social network VKontakte "Rashka quilted jacket square" (on the left photo) has 66 thousand subscribers and occupies 21st place in the list of media denigrating Russia. 4 months ago the FSB put him on the federal wanted list. [REDACTED] a Russian citizen, a 24-year-old native of Omsk, who has been involved in public activities since 2007, arrived in Almaty. [REDACTED] found out for what purpose.

When asked why he decided to share such information, [REDACTED] replied that "in light of recent events, he has been banned from entering Russia one way or another." Now he is in Mexico, and in

Now [REDACTED] has flown from Mexico via Frankfurt with a transfer in Kyiv. At Kyiv customs, because of his Russian passport, he was examined very carefully. He introduced himself as a blogger with an anti-Russian position, and they let him through. German had no difficulties crossing the Kazakh border, and to this day neither the police nor the intelligence services bother him, despite the fact that four months ago his mother was summoned for questioning by the FSB because her son was put on the federal wanted list. At the same time, he is ready for detention and subsequent deportation to Russia.

Once in Mexico, Mr. G took an illegal 3 month excursion into the US, calling the "three month adventure" an "unforgettable one". Only he can say why he wanted to visit the capital of western Satanism and LGBT degeneracy.

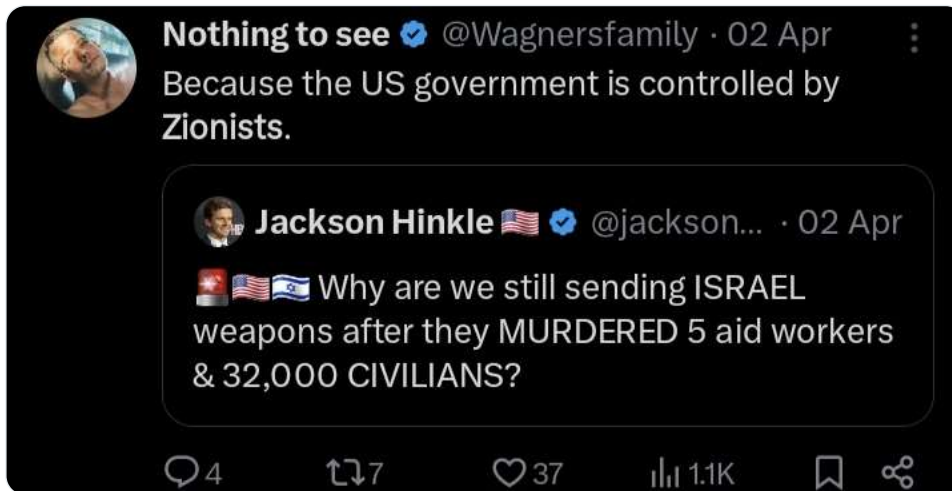

ABOUT VATNIK



"Vatnik" is a popular Internet meme in Russia and some CIS countries, created in 2011. Today Vatnik is becoming increasingly famous in Europe and the USA.

Who are they called Vatniks? This is a collective image of a Russian crazy and stupid patriot, conservative, traditionalist without critical thinking. Vatnik loves Putin, wants to revive the USSR; hates the USA, Europe and their allies (because he actually envies them).

Vatnik is a terrible homophobe, he is a hypocrite and a prude. Vatnik is prone to lies and violence, but is actually very cowardly. Vatnik believes in a conspiracy of the whole world against Russia and in everyone who disagrees with him, he sees enemies: his personal ones and the Motherland. Vatnik is obsessed with Victory Day and has made this date a cult, with religious worship of the Grandfathers and Stalin.

Every Vatnik dreams of a Leader who will rule Russia with a "harsh hand," put those who disagree with the regime in camps, execute gays and liberals, and will be able to defeat the United States. Vatnik lacks any self-irony; he is very complex. Vatnik hates human rights.

Vatnik loves to drink vodka, so he is often drunk, like most Russians. He got one eye blackened in a fight with fellow Russian patriots and supporters of the communists and Putin.

"Conservative traditionalist who loves Putin" ✓

G describes himself as a right wing conservative. He considers feminism the origin of "western degradation", even running an anti-feminist group on VK. He proudly declares he voted for Putin, describing him as a great man.
