In 2019, Mike flew solo to Russia after the rest of his delegation were denied visas. While others backed out, he insisted on holding private talks with Russian officials — because nothing says "America First" like going to Russia to "do politics".

GOP Sen. Mike Lee of Utah was granted a visa after two other senators were denied. Lee says his solo talks with Russian government officials will help the U.S. maintain an open dialogue with Russia.

In a 2022 debate, Mikey was grilled over his ties to Russia. Along with Rand Paul, he's the only US senator not blacklisted by Moscow. Both voted against a major Russia sanctions bill in 2017, earning Lee the nickname "Putin's most reliable yes man in the Senate."

According to Mikey, Trump deserved a "mulligan." He voted against a commission to investigate the attack, then pushed disinformation claiming the FBI was behind it. All while over 100 emails showed his deep involvement in trying to overturn the election.





Since Russia launched its full-scale invasion of Ukraine, Mikey has become one of the most fervent opponents of U.S. aid to the defending country. There was a brief moment in the spring of 2022 when he voted for military aid and even joined a video call with Zelenskyy.

NATO commemorated the 20th anniversary of the 9/11 terrorist attacks on the United States with a solemn ceremony on Saturday (11 September 2021). Secretary General Jens Stoltenberg and the U.S. Mission to NATO's Chargé d'Affaires Douglas Jones were joined by members of the North Atlantic Council, and NATO's diplomatic and military community for the act of remembrance.



Lee Introduces Bills to Demand Burden Sharing and Oppose Ukraine Membership Ahead of NATO Summit

WASHINGTON - As Washington plays host to this year's NATO Summit, Senator Mike Lee (R-UT) is set to introduce a series of bills to address the strategic misdirection of NATO and the decades-long imbalance in defense spending. The summit marks NATO's 75th anniversary, a milestone that calls for reflection and a reassessment of the alliance's operational readiness and financial posture.

"European capitals have grown accustomed to U.S-subsidized security, allowing them to dictate policy without bearing the risks or costs," said Senator Lee. "This arrangement has been perpetuated out of deference to the so-called 'rules-based international order." It's time for Congress to remind the alliance—and the Biden administration—that It holds the power to make treaties, extend NATO membership, and conduct oversignt of our commitments abroad."

Senator Lee's legislative agenda during the summit includes the following:

Resolution Opposing Security Guarantees for Ukraine

This resolution condemns the Biden administration's recent 10-year bilateral security agreement with Ukraine. It asserts that the agreement has no legal force without Senate ratification and rejects it as a "bridge" to Ukraine's NATO membership. Introduced on June 20, Senator Lee will call for unanimous consent and invites additional cosponsors.

Prohibition on Ukraine NATO Membership

This bill amends the Mutual Security Act of 1954 to stipulate that initiating an accession process for Ukraine will be grounds for immediate U.S. withdrawal from NATO. Senator Lee emphasizes the necessity of this bill to prevent further escalation and undue U.S. commitments. For claiming to be a "devout Christian," Mikey's social media posts are absolutely vile. After a Trump-supporting gunman murdered two Minnesota lawmakers and targeted others, he posted: "This is what happens when Marxists don't get their way."

He also mocked Governor Tim Walz with "Nightmare on Waltz [sic] Street." After being confronted by two senators and facing nationwide backlash over his verbal diarrhea, "Based Mike" quietly deleted the posts.





Mikey's unhinged "Based Mike" persona isn't just a stain on the Senate, it's also a growing headache for his church. According to Politico, leaders of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latterday Saints are now debating whether his reckless posts are a liability to the faith.
