Internet experts are warning that Iran's sweeping nationwide internet blackout is being used to shield lethal crackdowns on protesters, cutting off evidence of state violence as unrest continues across the country.

"This is the worst internet shutdown in Iran's history," said Ali Tehrani, director of Washington operations for Psiphon, an open-source anti-censorship tool widely used in Iran. "Even Starlink uploads have been affected."

Iran was plunged into a nationwide internet blackout Thursday evening as mass **anti-government protests** spread around the country, with Iranians shouting slogans against the ruling theocratic regime as anger mounts over economic turmoil and security crackdowns.

Authorities cut internet access and telephone lines immediately after Thursday's protests in the capital Tehran and other major cities began, although the blackout did not immediately prevent the posting of videos of the protests, now well into their second week.

"National blackouts tend to be the regime's go-to strategy when deadly force is about to get used against protesters," Alp Toker, director of cybersecurity watchdog NetBlocks, told CNN, "with the goal being to prevent the spread of news of what's happening on ground, and also to limit international scrutiny."

There are basically two ways now to get through the countrywide Internet blackout: Starlink, heavily jammed but usually working, and a state-controlled whitelist. Only regime officials and a limited number of businessmen get the whitelist Internet access.


Iran's Internet Came Back – But Not for Everyone

Iran's internet returned back to normal for people and businesses on a special, state-approved "white list", but access is patchy, restricted, and slow for everyone else.



There are therefore two kinds of information that leave the country: testimonies from the protesters, and the regime's Basiji propaganda. As both are limited, the media outside the country play a crucial role. The regime has few direct voices but many allies abroad.





Before the 1979 revolution, besides liberals and nationalists, which never supported the Islamic Republic, there were three main groups fighting against the Shah: Islamists, communists, and Islamist communists. Moscow was involved as well, as usual:

President of National Council of Resistance of Iran Meets Iraqi President



Mr. Massoud Rajavi, President of the National Council of Resistance of Iran (NCRI), met and held talks on Sunday, January 17, with Iraqi President Saddam Hussein at the Presidential Palace in Baghdad. Views were exchanged on regional affairs. The NCRI President expressed hope that the New Year would see the end of the war and be the final year for the Khomeini regime,

The victorious offensives of the National Liberation Army of Iran and the severe blows it has delivered to the regime's apparatus of war and repression have gained much attention internationally. The Los Angeles Times published a report by G.H. Jansen, who visited the Iran-Iraq border region and one of the NLA military centers, in its December 20 issue. Excerpts:

More than a few American universities are unknowingly making a direct and forceful contribution to the liberation of Iran from the rule of the Ayatollah Ruhollah Khomeini and his mullahs. The

contribution is in the form of alumni serving as soldiers and officers in the ranks of the National Liberation Army of Iran.

The NLA is the combat element of the socialist Moujahedeen (“Holy Warriors”) movement that has become the most effective group in opposition to the Khomeini regime—thanks in large part to French Prime Minister Jacques Chirac. Yielding to Iranian pressure, he expelled Moujahedeen leader Massoud Rajavi and many of his followers from France in June, 1986. They went to Iraq

New Round in Power Struggle Khomeini Loses Grip on Infigtings

A written rebuke recently addressed by Khomeini to his President, Khomeini, announced renewed infighting within Khomeini's regime, hastening its disintegration. On January 8, “Voice of Mojahed” radio broadcast an interview with Mr. Massoud Rajavi, President of the National Council of Resistance of Iran. Excerpts of the program, heard throughout Iran, appear below.

Khomeini's Latest Attack Costs 10,000 Iranian Casualties

The Khomeini regime's forces launched another war offensive on January 15 from the Sardasht region in the northern sector of the Iran-Iraq war-front. But the regime's radio reported the attack sixty hours later, after it had been established that it was yet another defeat.

The operation was reportedly intended to capture the heights overlooking the Mawet region and to “purge the region” and “the communication routes” used by the National Liberation Army.

The attack was launched from a mountainous region in very cold weather. A flood of casualties soon poured into field hospitals and hospitals in Tehran and Azarbaijan, particularly Martyrs Hospital in Tabriz. The wounded were transferred by train, C-130 cargo plane and car.

Eyewitnesses were struck by the chaotic situation of Khomeini's forces. The

2. Taking photos and filming the "consequences of the American bombing". If there aren't enough bodies, a few more will be added from the morgue full of corpses of killed protesters.


Morgue near Tehran overwhelmed by bodies amid protest crackdown

False and outdated videos circulated online after the Iran strikes.

Almost as soon as the United States and Israel launched attacks against Iran on Saturday, a surge of false and misleading videos flooded social media platforms.

Many of the videos gaining attention were outdated but real, depicting earlier conflicts unrelated to the attacks in Iran. Others are part of a new wave of artificial intelligence-generated fakes that show lifelike depictions of war. Some users shared realistic-seeming footage that was actually from video games.

Those videos have circulated online alongside genuine footage emerging from Iran and other places, making it difficult to know what was real.

Many of the posts have been viewed millions of times on X, TikTok and other platforms.

This chaotic information environment has become familiar in recent years to disinformation watchdogs, who have monitored such fakery spreading rapidly in the minutes and hours after any conflict begins. Social media influencers, eager for views that can translate into ad revenue, have quickly recirculated remarkable videos that they have found online — long before anyone can confirm whether they are real.

One post, seen more than 1.6 million times on X, appeared to show a barrage of fighter jets painted with the Iranian flag emerging at a rapid clip from a mountainside tunnel. The video was posted days before the attacks and appeared to have been made by artificial intelligence tools, according to an analysis by three A.I. detectors.

This form of “false flag” is not really new. Another classic, often also used by Iran’s proxy terrorists, is the use of human shields, especially children, such as having military bases near schools or military equipment placed directly in schools.


