Based on Dom Lucre, Dom Lucre is a massively popular Renaissance Man, who's dabbled successfully in military, hip hop, financial advising, philanthropy, politics and of course "breaking narratives". Hell, he even wrote an (everybody)Wiki about himself!

In many ways, Dominick is the George Santos for the black community, as almost everything about his past has been either exaggerated or completely made-up. A Twitter user @CoffinItUp (they're great, follow them and check their substack!) has made a lot of research on Dom,..



...and I'll be referencing to his investigative work quite often. First of all, Dom claims to have graduated from college in 2017 from Penn State, but they couldn't verify any diplomas or degrees. Dom then back-pedaled and said he's missing his "internship".


He's actually been enrolled to Penn State since 2017, but hasn't graduated after 6½ years. They even kicked him out once. Dom's also claimed to have obtained a certificate from Wharton University, but there's absolutely no proof of any of this:

Mr McGee has also his own business, Credit Cadabra. The site's been referred to as the "Most Searched and Serviced Financial Advising Company", which doesn't really mean anything at all. Anyway, it appears that he wrote a bunch of 5-star reviews by himself.



After some time, Dom decided that it was time to say his final goodbye to the military and shift his focus entirely towards producing HipHop music. But life had something else in store for him. After resigning from the US military, Dom decided to opt for higher education and enrolled in an online diploma in "Corporate Finance" in January of 2017.

After this diploma, a revolutionary idea popped up in his mind, and it was to create a financial counseling and credit restoration company. Hence, Credit Cadabra was founded in October of 2017.

In 2015 Dom Lucre left ML3 and became Vice
President of IVOS record label & clothing line, making
him the youngest executive and owner of a record
label and clothing line in the world at the age of 20.
After joining IVOS, Dom gained fame and much
success, even working with Icons such as Birdman,
Fetty Wap, Big Sean, Kanye West, Rick Ruben, Bruno
Mars, Ect. Dom is currently at the age of 22, and is
retired out the U.S. Army, IVOS currently has over
180k views on Youtube, 120k streams on Spotify,
200k plays on Soundcloud and currently ranked at #
62 in the country with their artist Hunter 6 Letterz
Single "Muchociliente" Dom is pursuing his dream to
make 3.7 billion dollars to honor his mother.

As is tradition with pathological liars like Santos and McGee, the lies hardly stop there. Dom's also lied about owning a 150 000 USD watch (it's a cheap copy), buying a house at the age of 22 (he was/is renting it), and having a net worth of 1,2 million USD.








Dominick has built his brand around being a black conservative who supports Donald Trump. He was also involved in the "Stop the Steal" movement, and even orchestrated his own FB group around the event called "Win the Win".

Most of his followers on social media came from running the group, which was also filled with QAnon references like "the storm will come." The group was also used by far-right militias for recruiting members.

Days later, in his chat room, one woman claimed she ran a multistate group interested in far-right militia tactics. She was recruiting members of Win the Win, and Mr. McGee could join if he passed a thorough interview and background check. He could even become the captain of his local chapter.

"We're ready for anything. We have tons of gas masks. Tons of bullets. Tons of magazines. Tons of A.R.s," she said, referring to semiautomatic rifles. "Anybody who's interested, hit me up. Hit me up on Facebook."

Dom has launched an NGO called The Citizen's Crusade, although there is no information of this organization outside of Dom's interviews, so it's probably just another made-up project of his.

Hi Dom, we're thrilled to have a chance to learn your story today. So, before we get into specifics, maybe you can briefly walk us through how you got to where you are today? I got to where I am by starting in the music business, I was vice president of a record label called IVOS from 2014 to 2018, I was living in Atlanta during my time working with the label. I decided to move to Chattanooga Tennessee to open up my business Credit Cadabra at the end of 2019. I viewed Chattanooga as a great place to start fresh, I worked in Chattanooga from 2020 to 2022. I decided to move to Nashville at the start of 2022, my business had gained a good amount of attention and success so I felt that Nashville was the right place for me. I have enjoyed my time in Tennessee, when I first moved to Nashville I was State Director of Blexit Tennessee which is a non-profit organization that is focused on underserved communities. I encountered ntless challenges to reach where I am but those challenges helped develop who I am as well. I now spend most of my tin cusing on the success of my new "Credit Where Rent's Due" program that provides free credit repair for homeless Ameri e always had my heart in community service, before Blexit I was a founding member of the Citiz that went to every homeless camp in Chattano ga where we did the land restoration, and pest o vitamins, and emergency services when needed. My time in Tennessee has been amazing, I was in the army from 2013 to 2017 as well, and during that time I was able to travel to many cities and states, there is no place in the U.S. that has made me as happy as Tennessee, nothing brings me greater joy than becoming apart of the history here and bring change to these deserving people. Although it wasn't easy I would never replace my story because it brought me to Tennessee.

Dom Lucre has over half a million followers on Twitter, and his "exposures" have relatively high engagement. These posts include ridiculous claims like saying that Tom Hanks is a pedophile and it was actually Trump that got Epstein locked up.





He's also promoted the Pizza Gate conspiracy theory, which claims that high-profile Hollywood stars and politicians are involved in a child sex trafficking ring. As an "evidence", he posted a segment from Ben Swann's "Reality Check" TV show from Fox. Swann has promoted...







...every conspiracy theory out there, and has made almost 7 million USD by the Russian government for his propaganda work for the South America, Indian and Chinese markets.



As most grifters often focus on what's trending, Dom has also written about Ukraine. In one of his hot takes, he stated that Putin is "fighting the deep state in Ukraine," and that QAnon is somehow connected to human trafficking in Ukraine.

He also shared a slideshow that was supposed to be proof that Ukraine is infested with Nazis - too bad most of the images were from Russia.

He's pushed the bioweapons lab conspiracy theory and also tried to connect Joe Biden's son, Hunter, into the production of "pandemic diseases that could be used as a bioweapons."










In addition, Dom's tweeted about the "genocide in Donbas". On 14 Jul 2023, one of Prigozhin's "trolls" revealed the "Donbas genocide" victims were actually paid actors. He also forgot to mention that a lot of the civilians died in Donbas came from the down shooting of MH17.




In Dom's view, the 2014 Revolution of Dignity was a CIA-orchestrated coup. His source for this is a far-left fake news blog, MROnline. He's also suggested that Zelensky is a war criminal and that the US provoked the war with Russia.

That's probably why he's a "black conservative" supporting Trump, as the truth is absolutely irrelevant within the MAGA gang.






