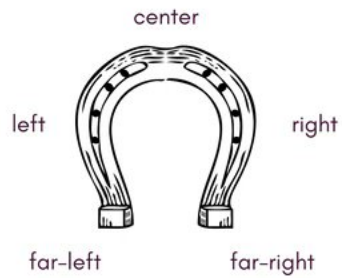

One could even say, that with Wagenknecht we see the horseshoe theory in action. In Germany, there is even a term for this: querfront (cross-front).

It originates from the Weimar politics referring to the cooperation between the far-right and far-left.

THE HORSESHOE THEORY

In political science, the horseshoe theory asserts that the far-left and the far-right are not opposites at the end of a political continuum, but rather, that they closely resemble each other, nearly meeting like the ends of a horseshoe, as in the illustration below:

When it comes to NATO and Russia, Sahra has a clear stance. In 2017, she called for the dissolution of NATO. Throughout her career as a politician, she's called for closer relations with Russia, and in 1992 she published an essay praising Stalinist Russia.

“P utin is our enemy now,” said Germany’s largest newspaper *Bild* yesterday. As the country woke up to reports of Russian tanks rolling over Ukrainian borders, the veil was finally lifted from German eyes: Moscow never wanted a diplomatic solution to the [Ukraine crisis](#).

Sahra Wagenknecht, of the far-Left Die Linke party, claimed not two days ago on German television that “Russia has in fact no interest to march into Ukraine”. According to her and many on the German Left, Moscow saw itself forced into a corner by Nato expansion and felt it needed security commitments from the West, “if necessary also by military means”.

She still opposed the sanctions imposed on Russia, stating that the German government had launched "an unprecedented economic war against our most important energy supplier."

After the speech, she was applauded by members of the far-right party AfD:

Protest in Berlin over arming Ukraine against Russia draws thousands

BERLIN, Feb 25 (Reuters) - A demonstration against supplying Ukraine with weapons for war with Russia attracted 10,000 people on Saturday, drawing criticism from top German government officials and a large police presence to maintain order.

Organised by a prominent left-wing German politician, the protest comes a day after the one-year anniversary of Russia's invasion of Ukraine, which drew promises of [more weapons](#) from western allies, [fresh sanctions](#) against Russia and [shows of support](#) for Kyiv across the globe.

"We call on the German chancellor to stop the escalation of arms deliveries. Now!...Because every day lost costs up to 1,000 more lives - and brings us closer to a 3rd world war," the protest's organizers said on their [website](#).

The "Uprising for Peace" was organised in part by Sahra Wagenknecht, a member of Germany's left-wing Die Linke party.

Germany, along with the United States, has been one of the biggest suppliers of weapons for Ukraine.





Few weeks before the rallies, Wagenknecht and Alice Schwarzer had collected signatures for "peace manifesto", calling for negotiations between Russia and Ukraine and halting the arms deliveries to Ukraine. They manifesto has almost 900 000 signatures.

According to her, weapon supplies to Ukraine are "highly dangerous" and they "escalate the conflict". Mrs Wagenknecht seems completely oblivious to the fact that Putin's Russia has been waging imperialistic wars since the start of the 2nd Chechen War in 1999.



In one interview, Sahra claimed that the war isn't about "Putin's nationalism", rather than about the neutrality of Ukraine. We should of course remember that Russia started the war already back in 2014 by annexing Crimea and fueling pro-Russia protests all around Ukraine.

In Oct 2023, Wagenknecht announced her intention to start a new political far-left party. One survey put the new party at 12% nationally, a pretty significant number in German politics. As a populist pro-Kremlin party, it will probably also steal some votes from AfD.

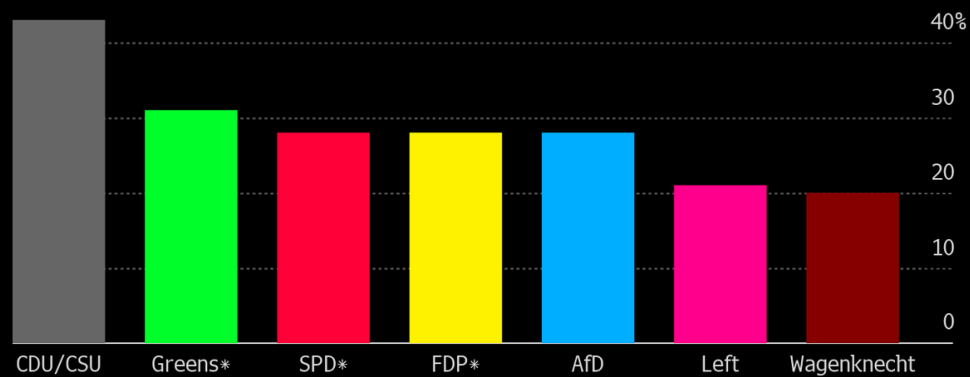

In Jul 2022, Sahra's ex-husband Ralph T. Niemeyer founded a "shadow government" in Russia and addressed Putin directly about this. In Feb 2022 Niemeyer suggested that Sahra should become the "Präsidentin-Kanzlerin" of Germany and called her "incurruptible".
