In today's #vatniksoup, I'll introduce a Russian scientist, businesswoman and former acrobatic dancer, Katerina Tikhonova née Putina. She's best-known for being the daughter of Vladimir Putin, and for making hefty profits after investing in AI and drone technologies.

Katerina was born in Dresden, East Germany, but some years later, after the collapse of the Communist East German government, they moved to Leningrad (soon to be St. Petersburg). Putin then started working for former professor & soon to be mayor of Leningrad, Anatoly Sobchak. 2/14








Later, during Russia's violent gang wars, Katerina and her sister were sent to Germany to safety, and were safeguarded by Putin's old friend, Matthias Warnig.

Perhaps due to the babysitting, Warnig was later given a big role in the Nord Stream pipeline project.







Allegedly large part of Tikhonova's wealth came from his first husband, oligarch Kirill Shamalov. Their combined assets were worth around 2 billion USD in 2013. According to Bloomberg, the couple separated around 2015.

Putin's daughter, a young billionaire and the president's friends

Tikhonova's trips to Munich seem to have begun in 2015, as the flight data shows. The following year, Igor Zelensky – one of Russia's most successful ballet dancers – became the director of the Bavarian State Ballet. It was at about this time that Tikhonova is thought to have separated from her husband, the oligarch scion Kirill Shamalov.

At the Bavarian State Ballet, it is no secret that Zelensky has powerful friends in Russia. Well before he became the target of criticism in spring 2022 for his refusal to distance himself from the invasion of Ukraine, he made a sanguine appearance in Crimea at Putin's side. He was also appointed to the supervisory board of Russia's National Cultural Heritage Foundation. His proximity to the regime was never particularly hidden. Nor was it a problem until the beginning of the war.

Katerina Tikhonova is purported to be Putin's youngest daughter, though given Putin's famous secrecy with regards to his personal life, this has never officially been confirmed. The Kremlin has ensured that Katerina is kept out of the public eye and she uses the surname 'Tikhonova', which is the patronymic name of her maternal grandmother. Despite the Kremlin's best efforts, however, it was



revealed by one of her colleagues in 2017, that she is indeed the daughter of the Russian president.

There have recently been reports that Putin is "quietly grooming" Katerina to takeover from him in the future in possible "tsardom". Currently, however, Katerina is a director of two initiatives at Moscow State University and is a competitive acrobatic rock'n'roll dancer. The rather niche sport of acrobatic rock'n'roll is governed by the World Rock'n'Roll Confederation, the same confederation that confirmed her to be Putin's daughter.


In the midst of the 2022 Russian mobilization and the Great Exodus, Katerina's dad called those who leave Russia and turn to the West "scum and traitors to their homeland," continuing that "their mentality is there, not here, with our people".





This hasn't stopped Katerina from traveling around Europe, though. Between 2015 and 2020, she traveled to Munich (and other places, including Sweden) more than 50 times with an entourage of


allegedly armed bodyguard - unnoticed by German authorities.



On most of her trips, she was meeting her boyfriend Igor Zelensky – one of Russia's most successful ballet dancers and former director of the Bavarian State Ballet. He has had a big role in promoting Russia's war in Ukraine, and he even appeared alongside Putin in Crimea.

Tikhonova's hobbies include acrobatic rock'n'roll. In the video below, she's dancing in a dance competition in Krakow, a month after the annexation of Crimea.

Moscow even built a 20 million USD rock'n'roll dance school, probably to honor her legacy and "achievements".



It appears that Putin has been grooming Katerina into success - for example, she's the director of Innopraktika, a \$1.7 billion development project to create a science center at Moscow State University. She got her PhD in 2019, but it's not clear if she wrote the...

Tikhonova is also the director of two initiatives connected to the university, the National Intellectual Development Foundation (NIDF) and the National Intellectual Reserve Centre (NIRC). She became director of the non-profit NIDF in May 2013 and later became director of the NIRC as well.

The NIRC and NIDF created and run a project at the university called Innopraktika, which is also headed by Tikhonova. It sponsors and supports young scientists.

Innopraktika has a raft of advisers and partners who are close to Putin, including Sergei Chemezov and Nikolai Tokarev. The two men were KGB associates of Putin during his days as a spy in Dresden, Germany, living in the same apartment block as the future Russian leader and his young family.



Due to her involvement in Russian defense industry and her family ties to Putin, Tikhonova has been sanctioned by the US, Japan, New Zealand, the UK and the EU.





Since the start of his military campaign against Ukraine, Vladimir Putin has railed aggressively against pro-western Russians, whose appetite for European cuisine and climates meant "their mentality is there, not here, with our people".

Yet his own daughter's enthusiasm for sojourns to western Europe at least matches that of the oligarch "scum and traitors" he has decried, a joint investigation by independent Russian media outlet iStories and German magazine Der Spiegel suggests.
