

In today's #vatniksoup, I'll introduce a Dutch right-wing activist, conspiracy theorist & social media personality, Eva Vlaardingerbroek (@evavlaar). She's best-known for her promotion of the "decline of the Decadent West" trope, and for promotion of pro-Kremlin narratives.

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Eva's main audience is conservative traditionalists, and basically everything she does revolves around this theme. She also promotes various conspiracy theories about the "global

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The capacity for the farmers' grievances to transition into conspiratorial anti-government narratives would explain why the Dutch National Coordinator for Security and Counterterrorism (NCTV) included a statement on the farmers' movement in its report on "terrorist threats" in the Netherlands. Their assessment was that while the protests themselves were generally peaceful, harmful actors were capitalising on them to contribute to existing social polarisation. In particular, the NCTV warned that the grievances of the farmers had been co-opted by conspiracy theorists and political extremists, just as they had co-opted demonstrations against government restrictions around COVID-19. For example, the Farmers' Movement received the open support of the Dutch far-right political party Forum voor Democratie (Forum for Democracy, FvD), which was invited to speak at one of

the demonstrations in 2020. Former FvD party member Eva Vlaardingerbroek even appeared in American television at the *Tucker Carlson Today* show to talk about the protests. In fact, she denied that a nitrogen crisis exists at all, which she said was an excuse for the Dutch government to follow their Great Reset plans over the Netherlands, a 'Pilot Country': "The Dutch farmers have had enough and are courageously fighting back against the Great Reset. They deserve your full support. They certainly have mine. It's very simple: No farmers, no food."

She's also a raging populist, and is not afraid to take current events and rally around them to get more attention to her conspiratorial ramblings. Recently, she's been involved with the protests by European farmers against increasing costs and tiny margins.





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In 2016, she joined the far-right political party, Forum voor Democratie (FvD). Some years later she became an intern at the FvD faction in the European Parliament, and soon left her position at the university in order to fully focus on her political career with the FvD.

The interview is in Café Dudok in Hilversum. Her parents live in the broadcasting city and she grew up there. Her French boyfriend Julien Rochedy is there. In the morning they were in Amsterdam to look for housing. Afterwards, they move on. For the past six months, the couple – Rochedy is a writer – lived together in Brussels, where she did an internship at Rob Roos, a europarlementarian on behalf of Forum for Democracy. That internship just over. In the coming years, Vlaardingerbroek will work as a lecturer-researcher at Leiden University.

FvD leader Thierry Baudet soon announced that Eva would fill the 5th spot on FvD's candidate list for the House of Representatives. Few months later FvD faced a huge crisis when its youth wing had made some extreme remarks, including praise of Anders Breivik &



In addition to Joost Eerdmans, the independent member of parliament Wybren van Haga and the Tilburg local politician Hans Smolders are also high on the list of the candidate list of Forum for Democracy for the elections in March. The first ten candidates have two women: First Chamber member Nicki Pouw-Verweij on three and right-field philosopher Eva Vlaardingerbroek in fifth place. She gained publicity on television and social media because of her right-wing views and her support for FvD.





Soon after this, many members resigned from the party. Eva was one of them - she joined a morning talk show in which she announced that she had chosen sides against the FvP leader and her former boyfriend (or "fling", as Eva called it), Thierry Baudet.

Joost Eerdmans, Annabel Nanninga, Nicki Pouw-Verweij and Eva Vlaardingerbroek leave Forum for Democracy.

For the time being, she left politics and focused more on political commentary and promoting herself on podcasts, talk shows and right-wing political events. She promotes various conspiracy theories, and often talks about the "The Great Reset" and its dangers.






In 2021, she appeared on Tucker Carlson Tonight, stating that Europe is becoming "a tyrannical regime, of mass surveillance and control". In the same year, she also worked as presenter of her own YouTube talk show "Let's Talk About It".



The show was part of Swedish media outlet Riks, which is affiliated with the far-right party Sverigedemokraterna. It seems that the show ran for only 10 episodes. She was also working as a legal advisor at a law firm, but her employment was terminated just after 4 months.





Eva then continued her career as a political commentator and speaker, calling for people to "reject Globalism and embrace God" at events like the Brussels National Conservatism Conference. She also became a regular commentator on European matters at Carlson's show on Fox.











She's also appeared as a regular commentator on Mark Steyn's YouTube show, on which she's commented - among other things - about how "young girls are being sacrificed on the altar of mass migration," and how the governments are trying to control us with digital currencies.





Like most conspiracy theorists, Eva often creates doomsday scenarios around topics she has no clue about, like for example cybersecurity and the threat of "cyber pandemics", which according to her would lead to martial law and the adoption of Europe-wide mass surveillance.

At this point, the majority of the population will probably gladly accept any restriction/measure out of pure desperation and fear. In fact, they'll probably be begging for it.




Of course, all of these things can and most likely will be implement even without the need for a cyber pandemic, if enough people comply. What do you think will happen?

Eva doesn't speak a lot about Ukraine, but when she does, she condemns it as a pointless money sink. She's also claimed that the whole thing is just another scheme to make weapon manufacturers and companies like BlackRock even wealthier.









After the Carlson interview with Putin, she praised the dictator's 30 minute revisionist history rant, stating that it has "current political relevance", and that no other leader could give such a detailed (biased and made-up) "historical account" as Putin did.



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Putin's 30 minute account of Russia's history was incredibly interesting, not just because of its current political relevance, but especially because it directly highlights the fact that not a single Western leader today could give such a detailed historical account of their own nation the way Putin did.

We in the West no longer have any idea who we are. We have no idea of our own history. Why would we? It's been actively suppressed and rejected. In fact, the only thing our current political "leadership" prides itself on, is the rejection of our "backwards history". When asked what The West is about, most people will repeat some type of cliché narrative that we've evolved past our nationalistic barbarism into enlightened "liberal democratic societies".

It's ironic because as the Putin interview confirmed once again on multiple accounts, "liberal democracy" in the West is an illusion. With the current President of the United States being undeniably senile, it couldn't possibly be more *in our face*. Our government leaders –let alone our parliamentary representatives – aren't actually the ones pulling the strings, but that obvious fact isn't causing the outrage you'd expect. Most people simply play along, even though they know the emperor has no clothes on. For some it might be because they don't know where to start or there's a level of cognitive dissonance and they aren't willing to face the truth, but there are many who are so brainwashed that they actually don't realize they're pawns in a globalist play.

In the latter case the brainwashing has been so successful that anybody who tries to tell them they're being lied to is automatically labelled a conspiracy theorist. It's almost like an immune response: The threat is immediately and automatically located and neutralized. These pawns are the most useful. As Goethe said: The best slave is one who thinks he's free.

To get back to the Russia-Ukraine war: You can dislike Putin all you want, but there is no denying that he is in it for his own people. He's in it for Russia and he has a clear idea of what Russia is and what it stands for. And the real question is, who are the ones really perpertuating this war if the CIA was behind the Ukrainian regime change in 2014 and a peace deal was reached in 2022, but rejected at the last minute because of Boris Johnson's interference? Is Russia really the expansionist aggressor its been made out to be, or has the bear just been poked too often?

One thing is for sure: this was a historical interview, which will be talked about for many many years to come and will hopefully contribute to the de-escalation of this conflict. Thank you, @TuckerCarlson.




