With the founding of the Weimar Republic in November 1918, the first democratic form of state in Germany became a fact. A long life was not granted to her. From birth, this republic has known many opponents who were strengthened in their ideas by conspiracy theories, the signing of the Treaty of Versailles and various crises of an economic and political nature. The stock market crash of the end of 1929 proved to be the neck for the republic – from that moment on the downfall of the already unstable democracy could no longer be averted, with the result that on 23 March 1933 Adolf Hitler seized power and began to develop his Third Reich.



But Raisa actually loves these kleptocracies, and she's only outspoken against the Western "global elites". For example, in 2023 she attended a "Science Summit – Uncensored" where she spoke about the conspiracy theory around the UN's "Agenda 2030" project...

Raisa Blommestijn (1994) is a legal philosopher, publicist and political commentator. She studied both Law and Philosophy at the University of Leiden. In April 2022, she successfully defended her PhD thesis on the Weimar Republic, the downfall of democracy and its decay towards totalitarianism ("The ghost of Weimar. A democracy in crisis"). She has published on several topics, i.e. freedom of speech, democratic theory, totalitarianism, the European Union and political correctness. During the corona crisis, she contributed to various lawsuits that were filed against to uphold fundamental rights.

Lawyer fed up with corona cases and ends cooperation with well-known critics

MAES LAW The well-known law firm Maes Law is immediately ceasing all corona cases and is therefore breaking off the collaboration with well-known corona sceptics such as Eva Vlaardingerbroek, Jan Bonte and Raisa Blommestijn. This is confirmed by lawyer Bart Maes to this site. "My office colleagues and I have been called everything that is dirty and ugly. Due to the enormous polarization, the emotional and financial costs have simply proven to be too high."

In the public debate, Maes's company was regularly under fire because they were said to underestimate the seriousness of the corona crisis. "I was a traitor and the boss of a wappie office that tried to capitalize on the crisis. That's not worth it to me. It cost me tons and a lot of sleep. So we are withdrawing completely." According to Maes, the behavior of some corona critics also played a role in the decision.

"I am incredibly shocked that a small number of corona demonstrators have seamlessly switched to supporting Russian President Vladimir Putin. These people are now starting to harass me because I have the Ukrainian flag in my Twitter bio. According to them, I am a traitor. That has affected me personally," says Maes. "I have many clients from Ukraine and also know people who have been victims there. I am really not going to let them down."

And it was clear that Raisa had chosen her side, when she wrote on X that "The people with a Ukrainian flag in the bio, who boycott Russian products and send money to Ukraine. Virtuous people who do their "duty". What an emptiness.'

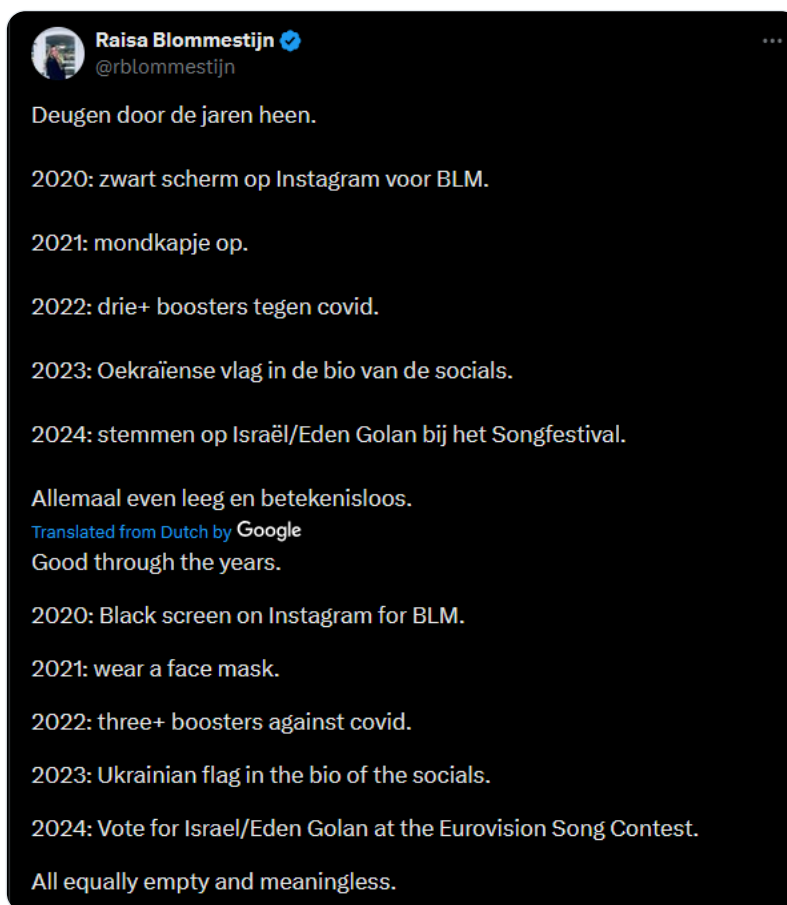

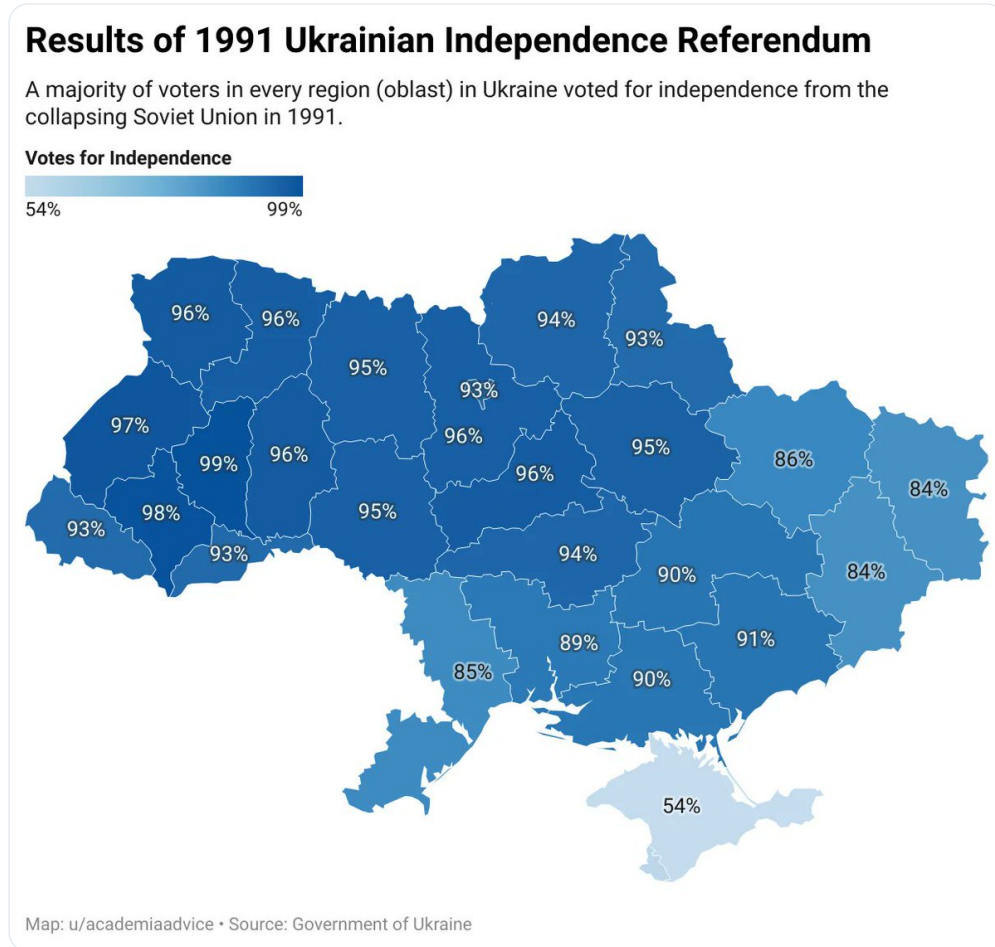

We are slowly being dragged into a Third World War. The 50 billion from the EU to Ukraine is the most recent and clear example. The EU gives money to Ukraine to make it possible for the country to buy weapons to fight Russia. In this way, the EU is at least indirectly at war with Russia at this moment.

In addition, there is of course the (re) introduction of conscription, for which the minds are currently being prepared. It is not without reason that the media, in the Netherlands and abroad, regularly reports on the danger of Russia and how important it is to be alert. And believe me: Defence does not want that mandatory questionnaire for 17-year-olds just like that.

What is actually happening in Ukraine and how the conflict is viewed from the Russian side, nobody knows. Although it is not a welcome message, there is just as much propaganda here in the "free West" as there is in Russia.

It is not surprising that the American government wanted to prevent the interview between [@TuckerCarlson](#) and Putin. They even monitored the conversations he had via Signal. The interview could be the bridge that the established politics does not want to be built: it is a way of real truth-finding that goes against the narrative and propaganda.

It may well open many eyes in this way - we should look forward to it with great interest.

The fact that the US government tried to prevent the interview of [@TuckerCarlson](#) and Putin twice says it all. Established politics and mainstream media are terrified of an uncensored interview; of real journalism and freedom of speech.

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Putin's 30 minute account of Russia's history was incredibly interesting, not just because of its current political relevance, but especially because it directly highlights the fact that not a single Western leader today could give such a detailed historical account of their own nation the way Putin did.

We in the West no longer have any idea who we are. We have no idea of our own history. Why would we? It's been actively suppressed and rejected. In fact, the only thing our current political "leadership" prides itself on, is the rejection of our "backwards history". When asked what The West is about, most people will repeat some type of cliché narrative that we've evolved past our nationalistic barbarism into enlightened "liberal democratic societies".

It's ironic because as the Putin interview confirmed once again on multiple accounts, "liberal democracy" in the West is an illusion. With the current President of the United States being undeniably senile, it couldn't possibly be more *in our face*. Our government leaders -let alone our parliamentary representatives - aren't actually the ones pulling the strings, but that obvious fact isn't causing the outrage you'd expect. Most people simply play along, even though they know the emperor has no clothes on. For some it might be because they don't know where to start or there's a level of cognitive dissonance and they aren't willing to face the truth, but there are many who are so brainwashed that they actually don't realize they're pawns in a globalist play.

In the latter case the brainwashing has been so successful that anybody who tries to tell them they're being lied to is automatically labelled a conspiracy theorist. It's almost like an immune response: The threat is immediately and automatically located and neutralized. These pawns are the most useful. As Goethe said: The best slave is one who thinks he's free.

To get back to the Russia-Ukraine war: You can dislike Putin all you want, but there is no denying that he is in it for his own people. He's in it for Russia and he has a clear idea of what Russia is and what it stands for. And the real question is, who are the ones really perpetuating this war if the CIA was behind the Ukrainian regime change in 2014 and a peace deal was reached in 2022, but rejected at the last minute because of Boris Johnson's interference? Is Russia really the expansionist aggressor its been made out to be, or has the bear just been poked too often?

One thing is for sure: this was a historical interview, which will be talked about for many many years to come and will hopefully contribute to the de-escalation of this conflict. Thank you, [@TuckerCarlson](#).

Blommestijn is one of those Western pro-Kremlin propagandists who has been able to break into the mainstream - she works as a presenter for Ongehoord Nederland, a Dutch show that claims to give a voice to those "who do not feel represented in the current politics and media."

Ongehoord (meaning “unheard”) was launched (among others) by Arnold Karskens and Joost Niemoller, and it started broadcasting just a few days before Russia launched their barbaric full-scale invasion against Ukraine. Raisa ended up fighting with Mr. Karskens...



...over her online behavior, and was told to leave X but refused. Raisa then had to leave Ongehoord in early 2024. Six months later, a new tribal battle ensued. Karskens lost this one, and Raisa returned to the screen.

Blommestijn calls Karskens' request "nothing less than an attempt to censor me and my accounts". The presenter thinks it is "completely at odds with the values that I thought were also defended by and at Ongehoord Nederland: freedom of speech and freedom of the press".

"I absolutely cannot agree with this. If I were to agree, I would be selling my soul," says Blommestijn, who states that "the fight for freedom of speech" is the most important thing for her. "For me, the fight for freedom of speech will of course continue. I will not let anyone silence me."

On its website, ON! [responds](#) to Blommestijn's departure. "As a broadcaster, we strive for accurate reporting and are committed to the truth. We have repeatedly requested Raisa Blommestijn, in her role as presenter of *Ongehoord Nieuws*, to be careful with her online statements," the message reads.

The broadcaster says it is not guilty of censorship. "Opinions can differ about correct journalistic conduct. That is different from censorship."

Recently, Raisa was struck with a lawsuit for using the terms 'toddler f*cker' (defamation) and 'n*groid primates' (group defamation).

According to court journalist @chrisklomp, the case will be heard on 21 Nov 2024.



It concerns a tweet that the suspect posted on May 10, 2023, in response to a video of an assault. The suspect wrote: "Yet another white man beaten up on the street by a group of Negroid primates. How many more defenseless whites have to fall victim? Probably countless: the open borders elite is importing these people in droves, with all the consequences that entails."

The suspect also posted other tweets around this video, but the Public Prosecution Service is not prosecuting her for that. Those tweets are not about a group because of race, but about the behavior of the people who were seen in that video.

In addition to the fact of group insult, the woman is also suspected of defamation. She called someone a 'children's fucker' in a tweet, while the court had just convicted someone for posting a similar message.

The suspect has been summoned to a hearing on August 19.

Despite Ongehoord paying Raisa an annual salary of 93,000 EUR, she has solicited personal donations from her supporters several times. She raised money for herself after being kicked out of Ongehoord and after she was being struck with a lawsuit.

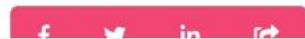

Completely brainwashed

Although there is some cautious protest and small demonstrations are taking place (like today in Amsterdam), most people seem completely brainwashed by propaganda. Not by the propaganda of the Kremlin, but by the propaganda of our own government, mind you. Blinded by hatred for Vladimir Putin, they completely lose sight of the fact that sending extra equipment such as F16s will pose an enormous security risk to the Netherlands. In addition, the conflict will intensify further, which will result in many additional victims. The meat grinder is running at full speed: according to the now retired American colonel Douglas Macgregor, more than 400,000 people have now died on the Ukrainian side alone. It will also result in more Ukrainian refugees coming to the Netherlands. Finally, Ukraine is still not a member of NATO or the European Union. Under the facade of defending freedom of speech and a fight against curbing freedoms, Blommesteijn regularly promotes the ideas of authoritarian leaders. Pretty rich coming from someone who wrote her thesis on the “erosion of democracy” and “rise of totalitarianism”.



Raisa is a useful pawn for the Kremlin because she amplifies and legitimises ideas from the far-right, which are then seasoned with crazy conspiracy theories and populism. This is nothing new, but Raisa has managed to bring this type of BS to Dutch national television.
